



NLU Delhi 2011 Analysis

The NLU Delhi test exam conducted on 1st may 2011 had 150 questions to be attempted in 90 minutes. The paper was easy but lengthy. There was no mention of negative marks in the paper. A brief snapshot of the various sections is presented below:

ENGLISH

The section consisted mainly of sentence completion and Sentence correction questions. The passages were lengthy. Within the time available, the possible correct attempts in this section are expected to be 21+. The time allocation should have been around 20 minutes.

MATHEMATICS

The questions were mainly from Arithmetic with odd question from Permutation and combination. The section was easy. Within the time available, the possible correct attempts in this section are expected to be 7+. The time allocation should have been around 15 minutes.

GENERAL AWARENESS

The questions in this test area were, predominantly, from Current GK. Most of the questions were easy. Within the time available, the possible correct attempts in this section are expected to be 21+. The time allocation should have been around 10 minutes.

LOGICAL REASONING

This section had an equal distribution of Critical and Analytical Reasoning questions. The section was easy. Within the time available, the possible correct attempts in this section are expected to be 23+. The time allocation should have been around 25 minutes.

LEGAL REASONING

Standard Legal topics were asked in this section which could have been answered, if the basics were clear. Within the time available, the possible correct attempts in this section are expected to be 22+. The time allocation should have been around 20 minutes.
