



SET 2011-BBA Analysis

The Symbiosis Entrance Test-BBA exam conducted on 6th May 2011 had 150 questions to be attempted in 150 minutes. The paper on the whole was very easy with odd speed-breakers in between. There was no mention of negative marks in the paper. A brief snapshot of the various sections is presented below:

GENERAL ENGLISH

This section was heavily leaned towards Verbal ability. The questions were from Synonyms & Antonyms, Sentence completion and Idioms. There was only one RC passage of 4 questions, which was easy. Within the time available, the possible correct attempts in this section are expected to be 30+. The time allocation should have been around 45 minutes.

QUANTITATIVE APTITUDE

As has been the trend, Arithmetic was the major area from which the questions were asked. The topics included Basic Number system, Time and Speed, Work, Profit and Loss. There were some odd questions from Algebraic formulae and Mensuration. There was 1 set of 4 questions from Data Interpretation. The questions were mostly on the easier side and aspirants would not have found much difficulty in solving those provided their basics were clear. Within the time available, the possible correct attempts in this section are expected to be 31+. The time allocation should have been around 45 minutes.

GENERAL AWARENESS

The questions in this test area were, predominantly, from Current and Static GK. The Current GK questions were easy and straight forward. The static GK questions were mainly from Personality, History and Geography. Overall the difficulty level of this section was easy. Within the time available, the possible correct attempts in this section are expected to be 25+. The time allocation should have been around 20 minutes.

ANALYTICAL AND LOGICAL REASONING

The questions were distributed among Logical and Critical Reasoning. The topics included Analogies, Logical Puzzles, Mathematical Reasoning, Blood Relations and Directions. The Critical Reasoning questions were mainly from Syllogism and Statement and Conclusion. The section was moderate in Difficulty level. Within the time available, the possible correct attempts in this section are expected to be 22+. The time allocation should have been around 40 minutes.

Below is presented the summary of the above analysis.
