Shaheed Sukhdev College of Business Studies (CBS) is a premier institution of the University of Delhi, imparting education in the fields of Management and Information Technology with excellence and vision. Founded in 1987 by the Delhi Administration on the initiation of UGC and the Ministry of Human Resources, Shaheed Sukhdev College of Business Studies, or CBS, as it is better known in corporate circles, was the first undergraduate management school under the aegis of the Delhi University (DU).

- Bachelor of Business Studies (BBS)
- Bachelor of Financial and Investment Analysis (BFIA)
- B.Sc. (H) Computer Science
- Postgraduate Diploma in Computer Applications

BBS & BFIA

The curriculum for BBS is rigorous, multi-disciplinary, flexible and continuously enriched with the latest developments in Management Theory and Practice. The students are required to undertake six to eight weeks of summer internship at the end of the fourth semester. Summer Internship at the end of the second semester is optional. There are six semesters, each culminating in University Examinations.

The Bachelor of Financial and Investment Analysis (BFIA) was started in 1999 to provide specialized course in the field of Finance at an undergraduate level. The program was developed and is being offered by Shaheed Sukhdev College of Business Studies only under the Faculty of Applied Social Sciences and Humanities, University of Delhi, South Campus.

ELIGIBILITY

The candidate should have passed or have appeared in March/April in Senior Secondary School Examination of CBSE or any other examination considered equivalent by the University of Delhi.

- The candidate should secure an aggregate of at least 60% marks (55% for SC, ST, CW and PC categories) in four papers including English for BBS applicants
- The candidate should secure an aggregate of at least 60% marks (55% for SC, ST, CW and PC categories) in four papers including English & Mathematics for BFIA applicants

The other papers are to be from the following list:

Accountancy, Biology, Biotechnology, Business Studies, Chemistry, Economics, Entrepreneurship, Geography, History, Informatics Practices, Introductory Computer Science, Mathematics, Physics, Political Science, Psychology, Public Administration, Secretarial Practices, Social Science, Sociology, Word Processing.

ADMISSION PROCESS

The selection process for the BBS/BFIA is through an entrance test and GD/PI. The entrance test is usually held in the 1st week of June. The GD/PI is held usually in 3rd week of June after the declaration of results which usually happens by mid 2nd week of June. Final Selection for all categories is generally made on the following basis:

Written test	50%
XII result	30%
Interview	10%
Group Discussion	10%

For the batch 2009-12 the batch strength is 163 for BBS and 54 for BFIA.

PLACEMENTS 2009

The institute has a record of 100% placements. Since the placement process is usually a long drawn one, hence complete information is not available. As per last information, a total of 107 students registered for placements, with 20 companies extending 85 offers. 3 students were offered packages in excess of 10 lacs while another 3 received a package of 9.5 lacs. The average package stood at 5 lacs. The top recruiters included Bain Consulting, McKinsey Knowledge Centre, CB Richard Ellis, Jaypee Capital, AT Kearney and Futures First.
