



## **NALSAR, HYDERABAD**

### **BA, LL.B (Honours)**

The BA, LL.B (Honours) course is the flagship course at NALSAR. The course is of 5 years duration. Each academic year is composed of 2 semesters. The Course Curriculum includes 50 credit courses having varying credit to be completed over a period of five years extendable to a maximum of seven years. This includes 47 compulsory courses and 3 seminar courses where students choose the subject to write a thesis on. Students are required to intern with Non-Governmental Organizations, Advocates, Law Firms, Judges or Governmental Bodies over the course of the winter vacation in November and December.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

To be eligible for admission, a candidate should have passed Higher Secondary School/Intermediate Examination (10+2) or its equivalent examination with not less than 50% marks in aggregate (45% in case of SC/ST/OBC and Persons with Disability). Age of candidate should not be more than 20 years in case of General/OBC candidates and 22 years in case of SC/ST and Persons with Disability on 1st July, 2010.

#### **INTAKE**

The intake is usually 80 with reservation of 15% for SC & 7½% for ST candidates and 10 seats for foreign nationals.

#### **ADMISSION PROCESS**

Students have to take the CLAT exam to be eligible for selection to NALSAR. Visit [www.clat.ac.in](http://www.clat.ac.in) for admission details.

#### **FEES**

For the 2009-14 Batch, the fees is Rs. 85,000/- per annum for Indian Nationals, US\$5,000 p.a. or its equivalent in Rupees for the candidates of SAARC Countries and US\$10,000 for candidates of other countries (Payable in one installment). The fee is under revision for the 2010-15 batch.
