### **The Honours Programmes**

The University offers unique five year integrated undergraduate 'Double Honors' educational programs i.e. B.B.A. (Hons.), LL.B. (Hons.); B.P.Sc. (Hons.), LL.B. (Hons.); B.Sc. (Technology Hons.), LL.B. (Hons.).

BBA (Hons.) LL.B. (Hons.) provides an integrated understanding of the interrelationship of Management Studies and Law in their entirety rather than in specified areas. Honors in Business Administration cover a vast domain of the contemporary areas of managerial relevance and provides the students an opportunity to focus on strategies to manage business in fast-evolving global environment.

B.Sc. Technology (Hons.) is an integrated program being designed to provide extensive knowledge of contemporary technologies, having direct correlation with upcoming techno-legal disputes and IPR issues.

Public Policy is the base of government and state on which the entire process of governance thrives. Public Policy is the dynamic face of State and Society. The nature of social, economic and political development of a society is completely dependent upon the public policy formulated by a government. Therefore, Bachelor of Policy Science Honors or B.P.Sc. (Hons.) has been designed in accordance with the changing nature of socio-economic conditions of the society. This is based on new developments in the wake of Liberalization and Globalization, which has led to the expansion of market-forces and the new kind of demand coming on the fore.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

To be eligible for admission, a candidate should have passed Higher Secondary School/Intermediate Examination (10+2) or its equivalent examination with not less than 50% marks in aggregate (45% in case of SC/ST/OBC and Persons with Disability). Age of candidate should not be more than 20 years in case of General/OBC candidates and 22 years in case of SC/ST and Persons with Disability on 1st July, 2010.

#### **INTAKE**

The intake capacity of all the three undergraduate degree programmes (B.B.A., LL.B. (Hons.), B.Sc., LL.B. (Hons.) and B.A., LL.B. (Hons.)), put together is 100 students, with suitable reservations for different classes as per Government Norms.



### **ADMISSION PROCESS**

Students have to take the CLAT exam to be eligible for selection to NLU Jodhpur. Visit [www.clat.ac.in](http://www.clat.ac.in) for admission details.

### **FEES**

The fee is between Rs 4 to 4.5 lacs for the entire duration of 5 years. It is under revision.

### **PLACEMENTS**

The National Law University, Jodhpur has an elaborate Internship program for both Undergraduate as well as Post-graduate students. The program is organized in the month of November - December of every year and it extends from four to six weeks. Various famous Law Firms, National as well as International, PSUs and Financial Institutions have always visited the campus. The pay packages offered by the National Law Firms range between Rs. 4.8 lacs to Rs. 14 lacs per annum, whereas the international law firms have offered packages between Rs. 28 lacs to Rs. 30 lacs per annum in the previous year. The pay packages of corporates range between Rs. 4.5 lacs to Rs. 11 lacs per annum for the previous year. The students have also been successful in undertaking Judicial Clerkship at the Honorable Supreme Court.
