### **DETAILS OF THE TEST**

There will be 150 questions. The sections tested will be English Language and Comprehension, General Knowledge, Elementary Mathematics, Legal Aptitude and Reasoning.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

The candidate need to have a pass in Senior Secondary School Examination (10+2 System) or equivalent Examination with not less than 50% of marks in the aggregate (Those who are appearing in the examination in March/April, 2011 can also apply). The age limit is below 21 years as on 1st July, 2011 (23 years in case of SC/ST candidates)

Interested candidates may apply for admission on the prescribed format of application available on the University website: <http://nludelhi.ac.in> along with a Demand Draft of Rs.2,500 for General Candidates or Rs.1000 in case of SC,ST and Person with Disability (PD) drawn in favour of "REGISTRAR, NATIONAL LAW UNIVERSITY, DELHI", payable at Delhi along with copies of requisite Caste/PD Certificate. There is no application fee for Below Poverty Line (BPL) applicants of SC/ST category (copy of BPL certificate from competent authority to be enclosed with application).
