



SYMBIOSIS ENTRANCE TEST (SET) NOTIFICATION 2011

DATE OF TEST: 7th May 2011

DETAILS:

SET is an objective test of 150 minutes duration. It is conducted in two sessions. A candidate may apply to take one paper from each session. The Morning session from 9:30 am to 12:00 pm will have papers from Law, Engineering and Health Sciences while the afternoon session from 2:30 pm to 5:00 pm will have papers from General and Design Section. A candidate may choose any one city out of Ahmedabad, Bengaluru, Bhubaneswar, Chandigarh, Chennai, Delhi, Hyderabad, Indore, Jaipur, Kochi, Kolhapur, Kolkata, Lucknow, Mumbai, Nagpur, Nasik and Pune.

HOW TO APPLY

- A candidate can register for one paper from the morning session viz. **Law** or **Engineering** or **Health Sciences** and one paper from the afternoon session viz. **General** or **Design**. Register at www.set-test.org. This will generate your SET ID.
- Pay a non-refundable fee of Rs. 1500/- towards the Test Fee and the prospectus of undergraduate programmes of Symbiosis International (Deemed University) or SIDU. The SIDU Admission Cell will courier a copy of prospectus to the address registered at www.set-test.org. You will have 4 choices of payment. It can be either by A. Cash B. DD C. online payment through credit Card D. online payment through net banking.
- Admit Card should be printed from the website. This will be operative from April 26, 2011 to May 7, 2011.
- **A candidate has to separately apply under each institute.** You can directly apply online for admission to an undergraduate institute of the University. The application fee is Rs. 1000/- per institute, except for SICSR. (The application fee for SICSR is Rs.1500/- for one/two programmes). After declaration of the SET result, the institute to which you have applied will conduct further selection process for short listed candidates.

The last date for registration for SET is April 14, 2011, while the payment closes on 16th April 2011. Please visit www.set-test.org for more details.
