



SP JAIN BBA 2010 NOTIFICATION

The Program is a global BBA program of 4 years' duration. The students have to study the first 2 years in Singapore and next 2 years in Sydney.

The students have to appear for an aptitude test and an evaluation process if shortlisted in the aptitude test.

The aptitude test is intended to test a student's IQ, Mathematical Ability, Logic and Reasoning Capacity and English Proficiency. The paper would be divided into different sections based on these areas. The test would be for duration of 1 hour. The format of the test may change from time to time but the testing would be on the mentioned parameters. Different questions may have a different scale of negative marking, and this would be taken into account while calculating a student's score. Generally a 70 percentile score is considered as the cut-off score, but the academic background and English proficiency will also be taken into account while short listing. Those short listed in the aptitude test have to undergo the evaluation process (interviews/group discussions), which will be conducted in Mumbai, Dubai and Singapore. The student will be informed whether he/she has been short listed for the evaluation process. Normally this takes a period of 15 days. A final offer for admission will be made after these 2 steps.

ELIGIBILITY

The Eligibility criteria for Indian applicants will be based on two parameters: Academic and English requirements.

Academic: The applicants have to satisfy one of the following categories:

- Successful completion of the All India Senior School Certification Examination (AISSCE) with overall grade in best 4 academic subjects where A1=5, A2=4.5, B1=3.5, B2=3.0, C1=2.0, C2=1.5, D1=1, D2=0.5.
- An Indian applicant would be expected to have an average of at least 60% in the India School Certificate (ISC) exam or the Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) exam from the Indian State Boards.
- International Baccalaureate (IB): Completion of the International Baccalaureate Diploma with no fewer than 34 points gained through the study of at least six subjects, three of which should be at the Higher Level.

English

All students would be expected to demonstrate an acceptable proficiency in English and tender evidence of this. Acceptable minimum scores for different tests are as follows.

- TOEFL PBT: **575**
- TOEFL CBT: **230**
- TOEFL IBT: **85**
- IELTS: **6**

A student could attend the evaluations before the Standard 12th results are declared and/or before IELTS/TOEFL score is submitted. However, a student must send S P Jain the Standard 12 and/or IELTS/TOEFL results latest by **July 1, 2010**. The final decision to offer admission to a student would be taken on receipt of these scores, taking into consideration the entire profile of the student.



HOW TO APPLY

The application process for the academic year 2010-11 has started. A student may apply online or download forms and send the same by hard copy. Applications received by S P Jain are evaluated in the month in which they are received on a rolling basis. In other words each application will be evaluated as and when received. Admissions are offered to deserving students without waiting for the last date.

Though the last date to apply is **July 12, 2010** it is advisable to apply as soon as possible. Please visit the link http://www.spjain.org/BBA_Admissions/index.asp for applying online. There is no application fee. The fee will be US \$45 for aptitude test and US \$55 for the evaluation process. **Detailed procedure for the aptitude test and payment for the same will be uploaded separately on the SP Jain BBA website prior to the conduct of the test.** The evaluation fee has to be paid only after the student has been shortlisted in the aptitude test.

Please keep one copy of the application for future reference.
